On June 14, 2023, the College's accrediting agency, Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC), placed East West College on probation. ACCSC alleged that the College was not in compliance with ACCSC standards regarding the accuracy and reliability of the information provided to the Commission, the adequacy and sufficiency of its management and the relationship of faculty to the students. The College filed a detailed response to the letter for consideration at the ACCSC November 2023 meeting.

On January 18, 2024, the College received ACCSC's decision withdrawing the College's accreditation. The decision states that the Commission found that the College "failed to demonstrate that the school has adequate management and administrative capacity in place that includes full-time on-site supervision by an individual or team with the appropriate combination of education, experience, and demonstrated ability to lead and manage a postsecondary educational institution in compliance with accrediting standards." The letter does not address the detailed factual points and arguments made by the College in response to the Probation order.

The College has retained experienced counsel and an experienced accreditation consultant to represent the College in an appeal of the decision to an ACCSC Appeals Panel. While the appeal is pending, the College's accreditation will remain in place. ACCSC has asked the College to prepare a teach-out plan.
