



INSTRUCTOR – ADJUNCT: TCM/BIOMED

JOB DESCRIPTION

All Adjunct professor faculty members must have formal training from an accredited college or school in their subject matter and four years of on-the-job experience in their field. The faculty member is responsible for being prepared and actively engaging students in the learning process during the entire class period. While the Faculty member may exercise academic freedom in the classroom, the Faculty member must adhere to the Master Syllabus provided by the College, the grading matrix identified therein, and all Academic Policies outlined in the Faculty/Employee Handbook and elsewhere. The Faculty member shall evaluate student learning, maintain accurate attendance and academic records, develop tests, and provide extra assistance where required. The Faculty member agrees to reinforce the College's attendance and retention policies through classroom procedures and to refer students with academic, behavioral or personal problems to either CAO or the Academic Dean or Campus President.
