

On June 14, 2023, the College's accrediting agency, Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC), placed East West College on probation with a subsequent review scheduled for the Commission's November 2023 meeting. We will be responding to this Order as requested and will demonstrate that we are in compliance with the appropriate standards or that we have taken corrective action. A probation order is not an adverse action. It is intended to alert the school to concerns that the school is in non-compliance with certain standards and to provide the school with the opportunity to demonstrate compliance and/or corrective action. This notice is intended to provide you with information about the probation decision.

The ACCSC has alleged that the College is not in compliance with ACCSC standards regarding the accuracy and reliability of the information provided to the Commission, the adequacy and sufficiency of its management and the relationship of faculty to the students. Other matters to which ACCSC requests a response include further attention to student needs, documentation of academic credentials of faculty, evidence that the school applies a fair and equitable refund policy, demonstrated use of the Program Advisory Service, demonstrated policy and procedure for handling student complaints, more information about the financial structure, and that the College maintains verifiable graduation and placement rates.

ACCSC also intends to proceed with an on-site evaluation of the distance education program, as is provided in the rules for initial approval of the program. Lastly, and in the ordinary course for a matter such as this, ACCSC has asked the College to prepare a teach out plan.
